In Libby, be sure to register with all our partnering library systems to unlock even more titles! Libby is packed with features to make listening easy

and flexible: Swipe the book cover to skip backward or forward. Speed up playback up to 3x. Set a sleep timer for a set time or until the end of a chapter. And much more!
