Summer Reading Begins June 1!

SUMMER READING PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

- Babies (3 years old and under) - Complete activities to receive prizes.
- Children (ages 3-12) - For each day of reading, you will receive a sticker. Accumulate stickers to claim prizes and enter drawings.
- Teens (ages 13-19) - For each day of reading, you will color in a section of a ticket. Once your ticket is full, come in for a prize and drawing entry.
- Adults (ages 20 and up) - Join our reading adventure and complete challenges along the way. Earn a prize entry for each completed challenge and every 5 days of reading. Read at least 40 days and receive a coupon for a free bundtlet from Nothing Bundt Cakes in addition to all your prize entries.
